

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2023

- In the 52 weeks to the end of December, we delivered 2,288 food parcels, averaging 44 a week (and 70 at Christmas), helping more than 100 adults + children each week.
- We delivered emergency food provision to more than 5000 adults and children.
- Each of our recipients receives bread, fruit, vegetables and milk plus other food including pasta, beans and tinned meat in the case of a family worth well over £65.
- 57,663 items were distributed by us in 2023, to 3,328 adults and 2,080 children.
- We help with basic essentials when we can, including toiletries, nappies and even pet food. Dietary needs are cared for.
- Our combined food poverty outreach projects now help around 200 adults + children every single week.

A FOOD BANK AND MORE...

£35,000 in extra local outreach

- Helping up to 40 people a week through our support for Milborne Port Food Share.
- Supplying hot meals via Sherborne Community Kitchen (now The Lunch Club) to 10 vulnerable people every week.
- Supporting 10 families from our area every week to attend Sturminster Newton Vale Pantry,
 a social supermarket.
- Paying for 20 pupils a day every day to have a free school meal if they are just above the threshold for entitlement.
- Providing free snacks, milk + breakfast to youngsters in need at youth centres and schools.
